

We are moving forward in the Mesa:

1. YOUR NEW WEBSITE. Your website, sunsetmesa.org, has launched and it is beautiful. To keep you up to date, you will find on the Home Page, lower right hand corner, the ability to sign up for E-Blasts. The webpage itself contains pertinent documents, upcoming events in the Mesa, ability to fill out and/or print the Architecture Committee Request for Service form, news and other items.

2. CC & R RE-VOTE. The ballots for the CC & R re-vote in Tract 26458 are going out this week, and the Town Hall Meetings begin tonight. You can find the information on the time and location of these Town Halls in the March edition of the Mesa-ge and on your website under Community, the Events tab.

3. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS PLAN. We are also creating a Disaster Preparedness Plan. Such a plan is long overdue in the Mesa . As you all know, we have primarily one ingress and egress, and, in the event of a disaster, knowing what the internal resources of our community are, e.g., doctors, vets, fire fighters, police officers, contractors, pharmacists, etc., is critical. Further, we have recently established the Buddy system. Older people or people with mobility difficulties, illnesses, etc., need to be a community priority in the event of a disaster. Let us not wait until there is a problem before we identify people who may need extra help. Sometimes it is difficult for people to reach out for a helping hand. 4. BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE. The Beautification Committee for Coastline is moving forward rapidly. We have a commitment from the County to plant at least 33 flowering low-growth trees up the corridor of Coastline to present a beautiful entry into our community. Additionally, any extra trees that are not replaced within the Mesa itself will be added to that number. The County has also agreed, in principle, to allow us to replant the remainder of the parkway, so we will rid ourselves of weeds, beer bottles, and other trash in that area.

Together, we can move into the future with pride and great satisfaction that we live in a wonderful neighborhood and had a hand in making it so.
